	able to pay part of the court costs and fees associated with this action before issuance of the initial process in this action. The prisoner litigant is hereby ordered to make an initial partial payment toward those court costs and fees pursuant to §57.085(4), Florida Statutes within twenty (20) days of the date of this Order. Until such payment is made, no process shall issue.
	Pursuant to §57.085(5), Florida Statutes, the prisoner litigant is hereby ordered to make monthly payments until such time as the costs and fees associated with this action totaling \$ are paid in full. The Court reserves jurisdiction to assess and require the payment of additional fees and costs if any are incurred.
	The Florida Department of Corrections or local detention facility shall place a lien on the inmate's prison trust account for the full amount of the court costs and fees associated with this action and shall withdraw the prisoner litigant's monthly payment, pursuant to §57.085(5), and forward the monthly payment to the Clerk of the Circuit Court at the following address:
