Hours of Operation

Court proceedings usually occur between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. There is typically a lunch break between noon and 1 p.m. It's important to note that schedules are subject to change, so it's advisable to have a backup plan in case the hearing or trial gets canceled.

Courtroom Observations

- Visitors are recommended to be at least 12 years of age or older.
- The subject matter discussed during a trial or observation may not be suitable for younger children or engaging enough to hold their attention.
- Scheduling courtroom observations in advance can be challenging as circumstances can prevent trials from occurring, leading to potential cancellations.
- For tours or observations, groups of 25 or less are recommended to maximize the experience.



Things to Keep in Mind When Visting the Courts

- Avoid wearing clothing such as cut-offs, flip-flops, tank tops, pajamas, etc. Business or business casual attire is suggested.
- Refrain from talking to those around you while in the courtroom; important conversations should be held outside.
- Do not communicate with prisoners in custody.
- Limit entering and exiting the courtroom; minimize movements once inside.
- Do not chew gum, eat, or drink in the courtroom.
- Turn off cell phones or place them on silent
- Limit extra belongings as all visitors are subject to security screening.
