- 12.902 (i)      Affidavit of Corroborating Witness (or one of the following:  
Florida DL, ID, Voter Card)
  
- 12.902 (j)      Notice of Social Security Number (FROM BOTH  
PARTIES)
  
- 12.903 (a)      Answer, Waiver, and Request for Copy of Final Judgment  
of Dissolution of Marriage (FROM RESPONDENT)
  
- 12.990 (b) (3) Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage w/No Property  
or Minor Children

1.     Prepare paperwork.
2.     File with Clerk.
3.     If no agreement or an answer has not been filed, ask Clerk to  
prepare summons and attach copies of paperwork.
4.     Sheriff to serve.
5.     The respondent has 20 days from the date of service to answer  
your petition.

6. **When the respondent answers, petitioner files a Motion to Set Hearing and a final hearing will be set.**
7. **If the respondent does not answer your petition after 20 days from the date of service you may file a Motion for Default with the Family Law clerk (form 12.922 (a) and (b)).**
