**SEVENTH CIRCUIT JUDICIAL NOMINATING COMMISSION
NOTICE OF VACANCIES IN THE COUNTY COURT
AND REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS**

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – Governor Ron DeSantis has requested that the Seventh Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission convene for the purpose of selecting and submitting a list of highly qualified lawyers for appointment to the Volusia County Court and the Putnam County Court. These appointments shall file a vacancy created by the elevation of Judge Katherine Miller and the resignation of Judge Anne Marie Gennusa.

The deadline to apply is 5:00 pm EST on Friday, March 27, 2026. Applicants must meet the qualifications for county court judges as described in Article V, Section 8 of the Florida Constitution. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Applications must be delivered by email to the Chair, Travis Mydock, at tmydock@mydocklaw.com.

The current version of the application (“Judicial Appointment Application 2025”) is available at: <https://www.flgov.com/eog/info/judicial/applications>. Applicants must submit the 2025 version of the application.

To be considered, an applicant must deliver the following by email:

1. A .pdf version of the complete “2025” application with all attachments; and
2. A .pdf redacted version of the complete “2025” application with all attachments, excluding all exempt information under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or other applicable law.

A complete application shall include: a signed Certificate, Financial History, notarized Form 6, Judicial Application Data Record, FDLE form, a writing sample, and a current color photograph. All questions in the application must be answered fully and completely. Applicants must include current contact information for all judges, co-counsel, opposing counsel, and references to facilitate the background investigation.

Each .pdf file should be titled so that the applicant’s full name and “original” or “redacted” is readily apparent before opening the attachment. The application and all attachments should be combined into a single .pdf file.

The Commission will convene in person on April 7, 2026 to conduct interviews and deliberations. The location and interview time will be published by a separate notice.

All proceedings of the Seventh Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission are open to the public, except for deliberations. Applicants should expect that their application will not remain confidential.

Members of the judiciary, bar, and public are encouraged to contact the Commission regarding any applicant for judicial appointment. All written correspondence regarding an applicant should be sent by email to the Chair, Travis Mydock, at tmydock@mydocklaw.com. The Chair will disseminate all information to the Commission.
