1. Prepare paperwork.
2. File with Family Law Clerk.
3. Mail copy to other party or other party's attorney (via certified mail) OR
4. Ask clerk to prepare summons, attach copy of paperwork.
5. Sherrif to serve.
6. After service, Petitioner to file Motion to Set Hearing with clerk (clerk will set hearing).
7. Bring pre-addressed stamped envelopes to hearing for each party.

**NOTE: For hearing to proceed, all of the above paperwork listed MUST be filed.**
