## **Out-of-County Plea Requirements**

Division 43

If you are requesting for your client to enter a plea on a case from another county within the Seventh Judicial Circuit, you must do the following:

 <u>Give a minimum of 24-hours notice</u> by email to the Judicial Assistant of the Plea/Sentencing Judge <u>tsmith@circuit7.org</u> <u>and</u> the Clerk's office in Volusia County <u>VolusiaCriminal@clerk.org</u> to request the out-of-county case(s) to be added to the docket.

In the email you must include the following:

- 1. Defendant's name and the Volusia County case number.
- 2. The **OUT OF COUNTY** case number(s) along with the Charging Document(s). If the case is a Violation of Probation, please include the **VOP Affidavit**. (NOT ALL CASE NUMBERS REFLECT THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE CASE RESIDES, PLEASE INCLUDE COUNTY OF ORIGIN)

This is a requirement throughout the Seventh Judicial Circuit. Please do not request for this Court to accept a plea from another county unless this procedure is followed.
