Courtrooms 217, 302, 305, and 316 have TVs mounted on the wall with VGA, Audio Jack, and HDMI jacks available for plug-in. You will be responsible for bringing your own HDMI cable to connect to the TV.



Courtroom 515 has podium hookups for the TV on the left wall of the courtroom. VGA and HDMI are available (An HDMI adapter to the VGA is connected at the podium). Both require the audio jack to be plugged in. The judge has control to turn audio on/off from the bench.



Please note that hearing room 400 does **not** have presentation options available.

The extenders below can be used to reach from the wall to the laptop.

An HDMI extension cable (which has one female end and one male end).



An HDMI coupler (which has 2 female ends) plus a second cable (HDMI).



You will be responsible for securing any cables you run across the floor, but you may **NOT** use tape with a heavy adhesive like duct tape. Instead, we recommend a Velcro-type covering, a molded channel, or tape that will not leave a glue residue or otherwise mar the carpeting, such as a light-duty gaff tape (often labeled as “easy release,” “clean release,” or something similar).
