

# ST. JOHNS & PUTNAM COUNTY VETERANS TREATMENT COURT



The St. Johns & Putnam County Veterans Treatment Court (VTC) is an initiative in the 7th Judicial Circuit designed to focus on the distinctive needs of veterans, military members, and defense contractor personnel who become involved in the criminal justice system.

You may be eligible for VTC if you serve or have served in the U.S. Armed Forces, Reserves or National Guard; are a current or former U.S. Department of Defense Contractor; or are a current or former military member of a foreign allied country. Inclusion in VTC also depends upon verification of service and a criminal background check. The current charge must be deemed an eligible offense.

For eligible individuals who have served the U.S. or allied countries, this court offers an avenue to resolve legal issues by addressing and treating the root cause of the alleged criminal behavior by a therapeutic approach using military and veterans benefits.
