1. Prepare paperwork.
2. File with Family Law Clerk along with two (2) copies of Final Judgment of Change of Name, (all filled out, except the portion reserved for Judge's signature and date) and one (1) stamped pre-addressed envelope (addressed to you).
3. Be sure to include your date of birth on all copies of the Final Judgment for Change of Name (Adult).

NOTE: Unless you are seeking to restore a former name, you must have fingerprints submitted for a state and national criminal records check.
