- 2. File with Family Law Clerk along with three (3) copies of Final Judgment of Change of Name, (all filled out, except the portion reserved for Judge's signature and date) and two (2) stamped pre-addressed envelopes ((1) addressed to petitioner and one (1) addressed to biological mother/father).
- 3. Be sure to include date of birth on <u>all copies of the Final Judgment for Change of Name (Family).</u>

NOTE: Unless you are seeking to restore a former name, each adult petitioner must have fingerprints submitted for a state and national criminal records check.
