12.923 Notice of Hearing (General)

- 1. Contact the Judge's office and ask the judicial assistant for a hearing date and time and explain what you need it for.
- 2. Prepare the Notice of Hearing.
- 3. File the Notice of Hearing with the Clerk's Office and mail a copy of the notice to the other party.
- 4. Bring three (3) copies of the final judgment (all filled out, except the portion for the judge's signature and date) and two (2) stamped pre-addressed envelopes (one addressed to each party) to your hearing.
