- 1. Prepare paperwork.
- 2. File with Clerk.
- 3. If no agreement or an answer has not been filed, ask Clerk to prepare summons and attach copies of paperwork.
- 4. Sheriff to serve.
- 5. The respondent has 20 days from the date of service to answer your petition.

- 6. When the respondent answers, petitioner files a Motion to Set Hearing and a final hearing will be set.
- 7. If the respondent does not answer your petition after 20 days from the date of service you may file a Motion for Default with the Family Law clerk (form 12.922 (a) and (b).
