

MODIFICATION OF ALIMONY

1. Prepare paperwork.
2. File with Clerk.
3. Ask Clerk to prepare summons and attach copies of paperwork
4. Sheriff to serve other party
5. The respondent has 20 days from the date of service to answer your petition. When the respondent answers, petitioner files a Motion to Set Hearing and a final hearing will be set.
6. If the respondent does not answer your petition after 20 days from the date of service you may file a Motion for Default with the Family Law clerk (form 12.922(a) and (b)).
