- 1. Prepare paperwork.

- 3. Mail copy to other party or other party's attorney (via certified mail) OR
- 4. Ask clerk to prepare summons, attach copy of paperwork.
- 5. Sherrif to serve.
- 6. After service, Petitioner to file Motion to Set Hearing with clerk (clerk will set hearing).
- 7. Bring pre-addressed stamped envelopes to hearing for each party.

NOTE: For hearing to proceed, all of the above paperwork listed MUST be filed.
