- Certificate of Non-Payment (per request from clerk)
- Affidavit of Non-Compliance (available for purchase only from the Law Library)
- 1. Upon request and after receipt of the Certificate of Non-Payment from the Clerk, the Affidavit of Non-Compliance can be signed/filed with the Clerk (the Affidavit of Non-Compliance must be signed in front of a notary or deputy clerk).
- 2. The Certificate of Non-Payment must be attached to the Affidavit of Non-Compliance and submitted *along with* the <u>blank</u> *Writ of Bodily Attachment (*do not fill out any information on the Writ) and the *Description Sheet (*the Description sheet is found as the last page attached to the Writ of Bodily Attachment. This should be filled out in its entirety as to the identification of the contemnor).
